

## The published figures...

...show a definite need for Conductive Education nationwide to help physically disabled.

- 1 in 400 children are born with cerebral palsy.
- 8% to 10% of children have some degree of dyspraxia. That's Approximately 2-3 in every class of 30 – 2% of which are severely affected.
- 130,000 people each year suffer a stroke with over 250,000 recovering at any one time.
- 120,000 people have Parkinson's. Figures are 1 in 500 increasing to 1 in 100 at the age of 65.
- 85,000 people in the UK have been diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis in their late 20's/30's, with more women than men being afflicted.
- 1 million people attended hospital with head injuries each year and 10% are left with serious physical or psychological disabilities
